

Camping Pittoresque rules

In order to make your stay and that of others as pleasant as possible, we apply the following rules during your stay.

General

- Arrival is from 15.00 and departure before 11.00. Departure is possible from 8.00 am. If you wish to leave earlier, please do so in the evening before 22:00.
- The campsite must be quiet between 11pm and 8am. If you return with your car after 23:00, please park it near the restaurant.
- Campers' dogs must be kept on a lead at all times, including on the pitch. Please walk your dog outside the campsite.
- It is forbidden to use radios, televisions, musical instruments or other noise-producing devices in such a way as to disturb other campers.
- Eclectic cars may not be recharged at the campsite. You can go to any supermarket in the area to recharge them.
- During your stay, you will be using the campsite facilities. Please treat these facilities as if they were your own.
- Visitors must always register. The cost is €2.50.
- Fires are not permitted from 1 July, only in the communal fireplace.
- BBQs are permitted, provided they are gas or electric (communicating with neighbours is generally appreciated).
- Smoking is only permitted in designated areas. Either on your own pitch or around your tent. Do not throw cigarettes on site.
- In the event of an emergency, all roads and the main entrance must always be kept clear of cars for ambulances, fire brigade, etc.
- On departure, the site must be left clean.
- Complaints, etc., must be reported to the campsite owner, who will reasonably seek an appropriate solution.

Sanitary

- The sanitary block is kept as clean as possible by us. Thank you for your cooperation in keeping it that way.
- Children under the age of 6 must be accompanied by an adult to use the toilet block.
- Toilet paper is available in the toilet block, please ask at reception/bar if you have run out).
- Smoking is not permitted in the toilet block.
- Please ensure that the toilets do not become playgrounds.

Liability

- Play equipment: use of the play equipment is entirely at your own risk.
- There is no supervision at the swimming pool and river, you are responsible for the supervision of your children.
- Do not leave your belongings unattended on the campsite or in your car. The campsite is not responsible for the loss, damage or theft of your belongings.
- The campsite is not responsible for the direct or indirect consequences of extreme weather conditions or other forms of force majeure.

Rubbish

- Household waste must be deposited in the designated containers near the tennis court and not in the bins near the sanitary facilities. Green is for residual waste, yellow for plastic and cardboard. Glass must be deposited in the designated glass container.
- It is forbidden to deposit bulky waste in or next to a container. Bulky waste (refrigerators, tent covers, tent poles, furniture, etc.) must be disposed of yourself.

Violation of the internal regulations or failure to follow instructions may result in a warning, refusal of access to the public areas of the Camping Pittoresque or expulsion from the campsite. Violations and offences will always be reported to the police.

We are counting on your cooperation to ensure that we all have a pleasant stay.

Safari tent rules

In order to make your stay and that of others as pleasant as possible, we apply the following rules during your stay.

General camping

- Arrival is from 15:00 and departure before 11:00. Departure is possible from 8.00 am. If you wish to leave earlier, please do so in the evening before 10 p.m.
- The campsite must be quiet between 11pm and 8am. If you return with your car after 23:00, please park it near the restaurant.
- It is forbidden to use radios, televisions, musical instruments or other noise-producing devices in such a way as to disturb other campers.
- Eclectic cars cannot be recharged at the campsite. You can go to any supermarket in the area to recharge them.
- During your stay, you will be using the campsite facilities. Please treat these facilities as if they were your own.
- Cars must be parked in the designated areas.
- Visitors must always register.
- Fires are not permitted from 1 July, otherwise fires are permitted on the communal fire pit.
- BBQ authorised, gas or electric, not on the veranda.
- In the event of an emergency, all roads and the main entrance must always be kept clear for ambulances, fire brigade, etc.
- Complaints etc must be reported to the owner and will be resolved in a reasonable manner.

General accommodation

- On arrival, check that all equipment is present and that the tent is clean. If any equipment is missing or your tent is not clean, please report this to reception by 8pm on the day of arrival. Please report this to reception so that we can resolve the problem immediately.
- Smoking is not permitted in the accommodation.
- It is forbidden to move the fridge, beds/mattresses and wardrobes.
- Mattresses, bedding and pillows must not be used outside the tent.
- Clotheslines may not be attached to the inside or outside of the tent or frame. Animaux de compagnie
- Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times. We ask you to walk your dog outside the campsite.
- Dogs must not be left alone in the accommodation.
- Dogs must not lie or walk on mattresses, bedding or pillows in safari tents.

Liability

- Play equipment: use of the play equipment is entirely at your own risk.
- There is no supervision at the swimming pool and river. You are responsible for supervising your children.
- Do not leave your belongings unattended on the campsite or in your car. The campsite is not responsible for the loss, damage or theft of your belongings.
- The campsite is not responsible for the direct or indirect consequences of extreme weather conditions or other forms of force majeure.

Leaving

- You must leave your accommodation clean and swept.
- Dispose of rubbish in the bins provided near the tennis court.
- Leave the inventory complete and clean (if any items are missing or broken, please report this to reception/the bar).
- Remove bed linen from the beds.

Violation of the house rules or failure to comply with instructions may result in a warning, refusal of access to the public areas of Camping Pittoresque or expulsion from the campsite. Offences and misdemeanours will always be reported to the police.
